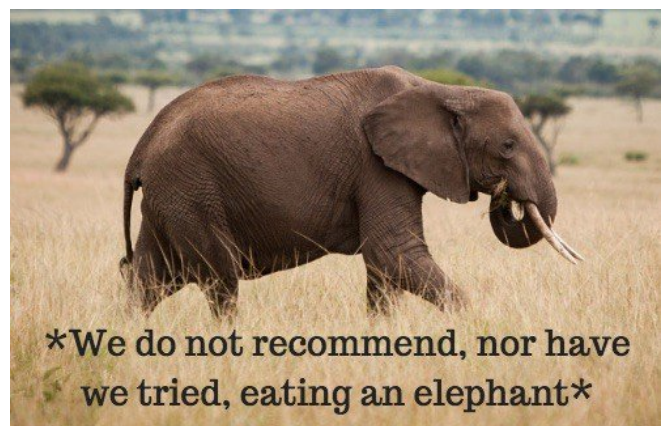
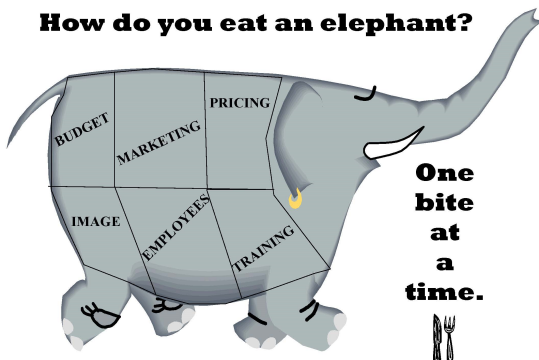

SAFETY ALERT - RAMP UP

- For starters, break the mountain of work into smaller accomplishable pieces. No one climbs Everest in one push.
- Identify the strengths of your team members and assign them to appropriate tasks.
- Encourage the use of the STOP model when things don't feel right.
- For those tasks outside our normal scope of duty, complete a pre-job briefing with the entire team involved. A chance for input increases the buy-in from the employee and can give chance to clarify any vague details.
- Don't rush to move through your projects. Take your time and complete the task right the first time safely. Slow is smooth and smooth is fast!
